We are pleased to say that we have gotten off to an exceptionally positive start this year. This is due in large part to the energy and enthusiasm of all of our students. This is a great time to remind everyone of our student recognition program that we began last year – the C.A.S.S. award, for “Celebrating Attitude, Scholarship, and Service.”

Our staff members have developed criteria for recognizing citizenship in our students. The goal of our discussions was to develop objective criteria to recognize the vast majority of students who contribute to the positive atmosphere on a daily basis. The criteria are:

- No suspensions.
- No Truancies.
- No Ds, Fs on quarterly report cards.
- No more than one detention hall.
- No more than 3 unexcused tardies to school each quarter.
- Participate in at least two extracurricular activities (band and chorus are included) during the school year.

We were able to recognize a number of students at the end of last year who met these criteria. Students meeting these criteria receive a certificate at the end of the year. We are looking forward to recognizing even more of our students this year.
