Dear Cass School District 63 Families.

Again, we hope this communication finds you and your family healthy and well.

To date, there is no change in the State's mandated "stay at home" and "school closure," which is scheduled through Thursday, April 30. We are still anticipating that this will be extended and have been planning accordingly.

There have been some minor changes in the District's operations, which I would like to take this opportunity to share with you.

First, our District facilities are officially closed, with only a few exceptions. We had staffed our facilities on a daily basis but due to safety concerns, we will only be open for lunch, construction projects (e.g., rooftop solar panel installation) and minor essential functioning. However, please know we are still available to service you. Please email or call and leave a message and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

Second, I am pleased to share, as you can see from another flyer in this NoteTotes, that the members of CARE have generously made personal donations to cover the cost for students' lunches on this upcoming Friday and Monday when school is not in session. These lunches are available to all students and will be available for pick up.

Our staff, while we are still hoping for the best, have been planning for the worst and continue to try to address some of the well-anticipated significant activities the last several months of this school year. Due to the logistics, we made the very difficult decision to cancel the Grade Eight Washington, D.C. class trip. The District is trying its best to be sensitive to families' finances at this time and will cover the difference in cost to make sure all participants are whole and do not lose money. This is with the same sensitivity and logic the District utilized in extended the registration fee payment until June 30 and prorated Prekindergarten tuition.

In regards to other end of the year activities, such as Graduation, Clap Out, Field Days, etc., while no official decisions have been made, we are currently looking at alternatives. If you have alternative ideas for any of these activities, please share them with your child(ren)'s teacher, principal or me.
