Vaccinations for Children 12+



Don't miss your chance to get vaccinated now!

All families in Illinois, including children 12+, are now eligible for the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. Families can search [Vaccines.gov](https://www.vaccines.gov) by the "Pfizer" filter to identify open vaccine appointments.

Options for accessing vaccination:



School: Check to see if a school near you will be offering a free school-based vaccination event for students and families.



Hospital, Primary Care Provider, or Community Health Centers: Healthcare providers all over the state are providing vaccines. Check to see if your family's provider has Pfizer appointments available.



Pharmacies: Families can search [Vaccines.gov](https://www.vaccines.gov) by the "Pfizer" filter to identify a nearby pharmacy with available appointments for young people.



Local Health Department (LHD): Your Local Health Department may host a vaccination event specifically for students and families. Check your Health Department's website for updates.
