



Regular and Special Drivers Needed Cass School District 63

Cass School District 63 is a small elementary school district serving the communities of Darien and Willowbrook in southeastern DuPage County, Illinois. We are seeking drivers for both special and regular routes as follows.

Special Needs Route Drivers

Potential drivers who do not wish to operate a large vehicle but would love to transport one or two students safely in a district passenger vehicle outside of the district are in need. Qualified candidates must possess or be willing to obtain a current School Bus Endorsement (S) license with no serious moving violations.

The school district will assist candidates as needed, including compensation for the training time required. Starting pay is \$18.00 per hour and the position is Monday - Friday while school is in session, but there may be flexibility in the days and hours.

Regular Route Drivers

The district is also in need of regular route drivers. Interested candidates must possess or be willing to obtain a current passenger CDL/Bus Driver license with no serious moving violations.

The school district will provide compensation for any training time required. Starting pay is \$18.00 per hour and the position is Monday - Friday while school is in session, and may also include opportunities to drive additional routes, extracurricular events and field trips.
