#### **Open Session**

#### **Reports, Updates and Informational Items**

#### A. Administrative Report

Principal Anderson gave an overview of the preparations taking place to start the 2020-21 School Year and shared that Concord Elementary School just received notice that the Prekindergarten Program has once again received the Gold Circle Award.

Principal Marcinkewicz gave an update on the planning and preparation for the 2020-21 School Year.

B. Update and Discussion Regarding the Proposed Return to Learn Framework

Superintendent Cross reviewed with the Board of Education the Proposed Return to Learn Framework. The plan includes a hybrid model of attendance with one half of the students attending in person classes Monday and Wednesday and the other one half of the students attending in person classes Tuesday and Thursday Students will attend school remotely for the remainder of the week. Parents may also opt to have their children attend school fully remote. Superintendent Cross also reviewed the safety precautions in place to help keep both students and staff safe. Superintendent Cross shared the results of the surveys the District has provided to parents and stated that the response has been largely positive and parents have been supportive.

C. Presentation of Amended 2020-21 District Calendar

Superintendent Cross presented the proposed amended 2020-21 School Year Calendar. The changes include a shift in the first day of school to August 24, 2020, a mandatory school holiday on November 3 for election day and an extension of the last day of school by one day to Friday, May 28.



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D. Presentation of Recommended Board Policy Updates

Superintendent Cross presented Board Policy 4:180 Pandemic Preparedness; Management and Recovery for the Board's review. The policy will be presented to the Board of Education at the August 18, 2020 for consideration of adoption.
