Principal Anderson shared updates on Concord Elementary School highlighting that Kindergarten Round Up which was a success. At this time, there are 76 students signed up for Kindergarten for next year. There also are currently 75 students signed up for Prekindergarten.

Principal Marcinkewicz shared updates on Cass Junior High School, highlighting Spanish and English Language Learner Teacher Katie Doyle's hard work in securing a multi-year grant which included new text books, and digital curriculum licenses, which equal out to over \$150,000.00 over a three-year period. She also congratulated Band Teacher Megan Duffy for a very successful Southeast DuPage Band Festival which was hosted recently at Cass Junior High School.
